At the conference October 27

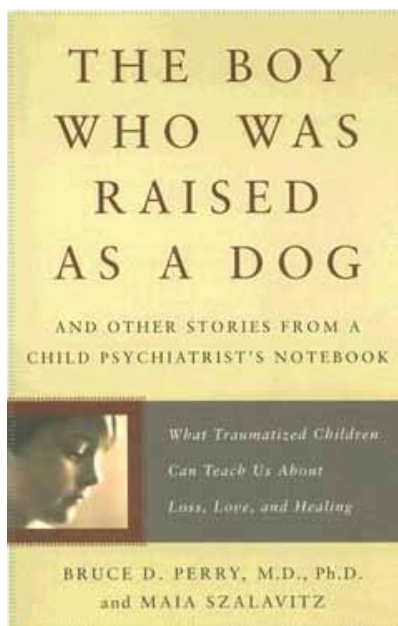
Dr. Perry will
